



Instead of overloading yourself, do the job in two trips!!





STAY ALERT Near Moving Equipment








FIRST AID Ministration of the Chemical Burn



Ensure that the area is safe and that you are protected from the chemical. This may involve wearning personal protective equipment[PPE]



Locate the Safety Data Sheets. This will include details of PPE requirements and specific first aid procedures.



The burn area should be flooded with water for 20 minutes to ensure that there is no contamination from the chemical to other areas of the body.



For eye burn, rines the injured eyes under a faucet, in a gentle shower ,or with a work site eye-wash station. Hold the injurid eyes open and flush them with a gentle stream of water for 10-15 minutes.



All chemical burns require professional medical advice following first aid treatment
